

FANTASY ICE

Dear Parents;

The Twenty-First Annual Ice Fantasy Ice Show will be presented at Cook Ice Arena on Friday, April 23, 2010; Saturday, April 24, 2010; and Sunday, April 25, 2010. We encourage all skaters (this includes beginning skaters) who enroll in the second session of the Coon Rapids "Learn to Skate" school classes to participate.

There is a cost of \$100.00 per skater to cover the cost of the costume and additional ice time used for rehearsals. The fee is paid in two parts, \$50.00 will be due when the participation form is turned in and \$50.00 is due on February 15th. Checks should be payable to **Cook Ice Arena**.



Rehearsals will be held at Cook Ice Arena. They will start approximately four to five weeks prior to the show with one or two rehearsals per week. The week of the show there is one rehearsal plus a dress rehearsal on Thursday, April 22, 2010. It is absolutely necessary that your child attend all scheduled rehearsals. A complete schedule will be handed out at a later date but a list of tentative dates is on the back of this page.

Skaters must participate in all performances or they will forfeit their place in the show.

We will have several measurement days. Skaters will be measured by qualified staff or volunteers to ensure a proper fitting costume. We understand small children will grow before April so we will add a little to accommodate growth. Mark your calendar with the following measurement days. Saturday December 12th 10:00 am-12:00 pm, Monday December 14th 6:00-8:30 pm, Saturday December 19th 10:00 am-12:30 pm or Monday December 21st 6:00 -8:30 pm

All Participation forms are due on December 21st or are subject to a \$10.00 late fee! **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Forms will not be accepted after January 1st.

Cancellation Policy (based on the total price): a complete refund will be given up to December 21, 2009. December 22-January 1 an 80% refund will be given. January 1-February 16th, 2010 (after costumes have been ordered) only the ice portion of the fee will be refunded (about 35%) and the skater will receive her/his costume. After February 15th the ice portion will only be refunded for medical reasons with a doctor's note.

Please complete the form (without measurements) and bring your participation form along with \$50.00 to measurement day. They must be turned into Karen or the Cook Arena office no later than December 21, 2009. Anyone who turns in a form after December 21st will be charged a \$10.00 late fee. No forms will be accepted after January 1, 2010.

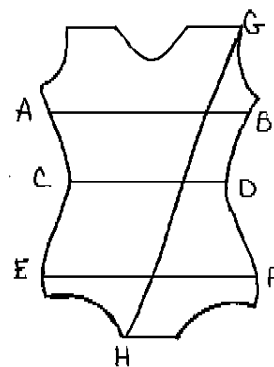
