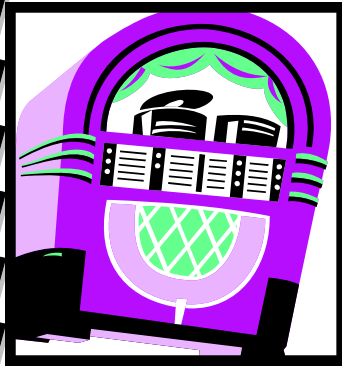

Special Number Costs

There is a \$30.00 application fee for all skaters who apply for a special number to cover the ice cost. Please include a separate payment for this fee. Make checks payable to Cook Arena. Your check will be returned if the skater does not receive a special number. All special number checks will be held until Monday January 4, 2010. A list of responsibilities for skaters in special numbers is listed on a separate sheet.

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The Ice Fantasy Special Number Responsibilities.

1. Skaters must participate in both sessions of classes at Cook Arena (Fall & Winter)
2. Skaters must fill out the Special Number request form.
3. Skaters should enclose copies of their competition results sheets with the form.
4. Special Number request forms must be turned in by December 21, 2009 along with a check for \$30.00. Checks will be held until January 4, 2010. Checks will be returned to skaters who are not granted a Special Number.
5. Skaters are responsible for their costume. All costumes must be approved by a member of the Cook Arena skating school staff. **If a skater is cast in a trio or foursome, costumes will be ordered and each skater is responsible for the cost.** When at all possible we try to order the least expensive costume to fit the music.
6. Skaters with a solo, feature or stepout will be given a copy of their music on the first day of scheduled show rehearsals. Skaters are responsible to arrange a time with their private lesson coach to choreograph the program. A separate choreographer may be used if the private lesson coach desires to use a choreographer.
7. Skaters are responsible for the cost of ice and lesson time needed to choreograph their solo program.
8. Any skater not following these procedures will not be allowed to participate in a special number in the show.
9. Skaters must perform in all shows or forfeit their spot in the show.
10. Special numbers are cast using the point system on display in the Cook Ice arena lobby.
